The HORSE**POWER** Therapeutic Learning Center has been providing therapeutic horseback riding and equine-assisted activities for thirty years, helping riders overcome physical, intellectual and/or emotional disabilities and enabling veterans to regain control of their lives. The HORSE**POWER** Foundation was started in 2013 with the goal of providing HORSEPOWER with a permanent, handicap-accessible facility to better serve its clients. Thanks to the amazing generosity of the wonderful friends of HORSE**POWER**, the Foundation was able to purchase land and gradually develop the facility, paying for things as we went along.

Since early 2023, with the development of our debt-free facility complete, the Foundation has focused on establishing an Endowment Fund to ensure long-term financial support for HORSE**POWER**. We know that HORSE**POWER**'s programs will experience changes in the future and will face unpredictable variations in expenses and donations. Our goal is to make sure our Endowment Fund can provide a consistent source of needed funding and enable HORSE**POWER** to continue helping community members with different needs long after all of us are gone. For that purpose, we have officially launched our first Endowment Campaign in July 2024 with a goal of \$1.2 million.

Our staff, board and volunteers have demonstrated careful stewardship of our resources over the years. Attentive and focused planning has enabled the remarkable progress that has been achieved in both the facility and programming. Now our focus must be placed on the future.

BENEFITS TO HORSEPOWER

Endowments provide a consistent and permanent funding that will support HORSE**POWER**'s programs for generations to come. An endowed gift is made with the intention to preserve the principal value in perpetuity. Because of their performance, endowments are among the most advantageous sources of funding for non-profits. HORSE**POWER** is subject to the volatility of the economy, including its effect on donated revenues and fixed costs. Endowments help ensure sustainability even when other funding sources become less reliable. As a source of consistent funding, our endowment will help provide clients, volunteers, staff and donors with an assurance of the stability of our programs.

HOW DOES THE ENDOWMENT WORK?

Endowment funds are prudently invested by the HORSE-POWER Foundation. The portfolio is diversified with a view to providing healthy long-term returns. An annual contribution to HORSEPOWERR will be considered upon review by the HORSE-POWER Foundation.

HOW DO I GET STARTED?

Establishing an endowed fund with the HORSE**POWER** Foundation is easy. A development professional will guide you through the process and discuss options that fit your situation and your wishes. Generally, the procedure for endowing a fund is as follows:

- The use and purpose of the endowed gift is documented in a written Endowment Fund Agreement (EFA) between the donor and the HORSE**POWER** Foundation. Once established, your endowment fund will be used exclusively for the purpose outlined in the EFA.
- Your endowment may be funded with cash, stocks, estate planning and more.
- If you wish, with a minimum gift of \$25,000, you can establish a named endowment at the HORSE**POWER** Foundation directed to a specific purpose. Options are available to allow you to reach the \$25,000 minimum over time.
